# PASSPORT REQUIREMENT

A Passport or other Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative (WHTI) compliant document will be required, unless otherwise indicated below, on U.S. Domestic sailings, upon entering the U.S. on or after June 1, 2009

**It is the sole responsibility of the guest to identify and obtain all required travel documents.**

Guests on consecutive sailings must have the proper documents for their entire cruise vacation. The requirements on this document were accurate as of June 2, 2009 but should be validated by the guest prior to leaving home through a Passport service or [www.getyouhome.gov](http://www.getyouhome.gov).
